
The purpose of the cooperation between ADYPU and SSSUTMS is as follows:

B. SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT

1. The Parties hereto express their intention to:
 - (i) cooperate in the exchange of information relating to their faculty activities in fields of mutual interests;
 - (ii) promote joint faculty and scholar activities;
 - (iii) encourage staff or students to spend some time in the respective host institution. The exchange of staff or students will be dependent upon the execution of a formal Staff or Student Exchange Agreement mutually agreed between the Parties in writing prior to commencement of this activity;
2. The coordinators from the institutions will prepare an annual joint report on activities in the areas of cooperation under this Memorandum of Understanding – upon request.
3. In the implementation of specific cooperative programs, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding and the obligations to be undertaken by each party, as well as the various aspects of any possible outcome (e.g. intellectual property, patents, copyrights, commercialization of the outcome, etc.) will be negotiated, mutually agreed and formalised in writing, prior to the commencement of the program.

- C. This Memorandum of Understanding / Agreement will be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the parties. No modification, alteration or amendment of this Agreement will be effective unless in writing and signed by the Parties. Further agreements concerning any program will provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and will not become effective until they have been put down in writing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties. The scope of the activities under this agreement will be determined by the funds regularly available at both institutions for the types of collaboration undertaken and by financial assistance as may be obtained by either institution from external sources.

D. INFORMATION SHARING & CONFIDENTIALITY

Each party undertakes to respect the confidentiality of the other party's confidential information. Each party is to treat all confidential information owned by the other party which

is specifically designated as confidential information in writing as confidential, and shall not disclose or permit the same to be disclosed to a third party without the written authorisation of the owner of that confidential information. Each party may request the other parties to enter into a confidentiality deed prior to the disclosure of confidential information.

E. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

All background Intellectual Property will remain in the ownership of the originating institution. Access to such Intellectual Property will be negotiated on a case by case basis and be subject to mutual prior written agreement. The ownership over any new Intellectual Property generated as a consequence of implementation of this Memorandum as aforesaid, will be negotiated on a case by case basis and be subject to mutual prior written agreement. Licences for the exploitation of Intellectual Property will be negotiated on a case by case basis.

- F. This Memorandum / Agreement is not a contract. This Memorandum / Agreement serves only as a statement of the general intention of the Parties and is not intended to be legally binding nor to be construed as an agreement on any matters mentioned. No oral agreement or conduct of the Parties (including partial performance) in respect of matters stated in this Memorandum / Agreement shall be deemed to impose any obligation or liability on either Party.
- G. This Memorandum / Agreement is not intended to constitute, create, give effect to, or otherwise form a joint venture, or other business entity of any kind. Neither Party shall act as an agent for, or partner of, the other Party. There are neither any rights nor obligations of the Parties established under this Memorandum / Agreement.
- H. All publications resulting from the collaboration between the two institutions must give recognition to the Memorandum / Agreement. Likewise, the Memorandum / Agreement must also be mentioned in all courses and formal presentations that result from collaboration under the terms hereof.
- I. The Parties agree to comply with all national, state, and local rules, regulations, executive orders, laws, and policies forbidding unlawful discrimination to which institution is subject.
- J. The Parties intend to discuss with each other press releases in connection with this Memorandum / Agreement prior to publication of any press release.
- K. The Parties understand that they are proceeding at their own risk and they understand that costs regarding the subject matter under this Memorandum / Agreement are to be paid for by the


L. TIMELINE





This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter MOU) is made and entered into on this 30 June 2019 between the Sri Satya Sai University of Technology and Medical Science, Sehore, [hereinafter SSSUTMS], having its premises at Sehore-466001, M.P., INDIA, [hereinafter called SSSUTMS/First Party] one of the leading University in the State of Madhya Pradesh on the ONE PART and the Ram Krishna Dharmarth Foundation University at Gandhi Nagar, Bhopal 462033, MP, INDIA (hereinafter referred as RKDF/Second Party) on the OTHER PART (who for the purpose of this MoU are hereinafter individually referred to as 'PARTIES')

The parties, having discussed fields of common research interests and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into long-term collaboration for promotion of students' training and quality research in cutting edge areas in accordance with the provisions contained in the Guidelines issued vide Letter No. 2/8/2012-HRD dated 30TH April 2014 or as revised from time to time.

WHEREAS the "First Party" is "A University which has been the vanguard of continuous development in technical education since its inception; Considering the expertise and facilities developed over the year's excellence and achievements in regard to standards of education and its overall curricular and technical developments the institution has been granted by UGC and other Government agency like AICTE, PCI, MP Private Universities Regulatory Commission and AIU.", AND WHEREAS the "Second Party", established vide Gazette Notification of 19 July 2011 of Government of Madhya Pradesh vide Act No. 23 of 2011 and recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC) vide 8-45/2012 (CPP-I/PU) is involved in R&D area of Renewable Energy, Climate change, Drug Delivery, Medicinal plants and Bio informatics, Internet of Things (IOT), Machine Learning, Big DATA, Smart Grid, Animal Husbandry, Milk Technology, Farming & Farm Machinery, Soil Science and Smart Irrigation. The second party in an association with RGPV is implementing India's first carbon capture plant integrated with solar thermal and STP and ETP Plant.

AND WHEREAS it has been considered expedient to agree in writing to participate jointly in the projects requiring expertise and logistics from both the parties

Article 1. Scope

- 1.1 The Chemical Department of SSUTMS will Use Carbon Capture & Sequestration, STP and ETP Plant, Research facility and library facilities available with the Second party and the

First Party

- Second party will be made available to the faculty and research scholars. However, the costs of specific consumables will be borne by the respective organizations.
- 1.2 There shall be an exchange of students for academic, research and training purposes. Accommodation in the Hostel shall be arranged, wherever possible, as per extant rates. The duration of exchange visits will be determined by mutual consent between both the parties.

Article 2. Management

- 2.1 Vice Chancellor of the First party and the Vice-Chancellor/Director General (Research)/ Director General (Management) of the Institution of the Second party will be responsible to work out operational details of co-operation between the two organizations and ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.
- 2.2 The Advisory Committee will meet at least once in a year alternatively in the institutions of the First party and the Second party to review the activities. This meeting shall include presentation on the academic and research activities, which should be open to the students, faculty and scientists.
- 2.3 The faculty of the SSSUTMS University Schore (first party) can be a Major Guide/chairman/co-guide or External Guide/chairman wherever applicable depending upon the quantum of work allotted to the student for guidance. For guidance of BE/M.TECH. /Ph.D. students there can be one or more number of Guides/chairmen/members from the first party.

Article 3. Exchange of Information

- 3.1. The term "information" includes scientific or technical data, results and/or methods of investigation, and other information intended to be provided, exchanged, or arising under project descriptions entered into pursuant to this MoU.
- 3.2. The parties support the widest possible dissemination of information. Each party in joint projects shall be given the right to use, disclose, publish or disseminate such information for any and all purposes.

Article 4. General Provisions

- 4.1 It is understood that the First party and the Second party subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, caste or religion. Both the Institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement and neither party shall impose criteria for exchange of scholars or students, which violate principles of non-discrimination
- 4.2 Both parties understand that all financial agreements will have to be negotiated separately and will depend on the availability of funds.
- 4.3 Both parties acknowledge that exchange of students from one party to the other shall be subject to the availability of funds and shall comply with the regulations and policies of the First party and the Second party.
- 4.4 All questions related to this MoU arising during its term will be settled by the parties by mutual agreement. Disagreements at the operating level shall be forwarded to respective higher officials

for appropriate resolution failing which an arbitrator of mutual acceptance may be identified for the settlement of dispute, if any.

- 4.5 All questions not foreseen related to this MoU will be handled by the parties by mutual agreement.
- 4.6 Nothing in this MoU is intended to affect other cooperation or collaborations between the Parties.

Article 5. Entry into effect, modification and termination

- 5.1. This MoU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the parties and shall be valid for three years extendable up to five years. Both parties shall review the status of the MoU at the end of each three/five year period to determine any modification, whenever necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may be extended by mutual consent up to five years. This MoU may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party initiating termination. Such notification must be given to the other party at least six months in advance from the effective date of termination.
- 5.2. All joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of the MoU may be continued until their completion under the terms of this MoU.
- 5.3. No amendment or modification of the MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be amendment of the MoU. The modifications/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to.

WHEREAS, MPPURC, the first party is tasked with regulating all the Private Universities in the state of Madhya Pradesh and is keen to leverage its infrastructure to help Private Universities in Madhya Pradesh to develop graduates with holistic skills and knowledge;

WHEREAS, all these collaborating agencies have complementary skills and responsibilities and core competencies. Combined effort of these agencies will help in a holistic and sustainable development of MPPURC regulated Universities, which in turn contributes towards progress of the nation;

AND WHEREAS, all the parties have held discussions and have agreed for collaboration for synergising their mutual strengths in public interest and to deliver a larger good for the society at large.

Scope of Global Collaboration

The parties agree to discuss in good faith the following projects:

1. The main objectives for MPPURC are:

- a. to introduce a standardized international learning and assessment system for English across MPPURC regulated Universities which is globally recognised
- b. to offer opportunity for students of MPPURC regulated Universities to gain proficiency in English which is internationally recognised
- c. to give teachers in MPPURC regulated Universities an opportunity for professional development

2. The main aims for the University are :

1. to improve of the quality of teaching and learning English in Sri Satya Sai University of Technology and Medical Sciences
2. to motivate the students of Sri Satya Sai University of Technology and Medical Sciences to develop English language skills across the year by introducing various language development programmes
3. to incorporate Cambridge English programmes in syllabus and integrate the syllabus for the benefit of the students and faculty of Sri Satya Sai University of Technology and Medical Sciences.
4. to offer relevant course credits to students taking up the Cambridge programmes as per the university policy.
5. to recommend specific courses proposed by Cambridge Assessment English to the students and staff of MPPURC regulated institutions.
6. to organize joint conferences, workshops, seminars and short term training programmes related to English language teaching
7. to encourage faculty to take up Cambridge Teacher certification to raise the standards of teaching as per AICTE recommendations

3. Scope of enabling services provided by Cambridge Assessment English to be availed by the University:

- b. Support to map various English language learning courses of Sri Satya Sai University of Technology and Medical Sciences with that of Cambridge Certificates in English Business Certificate, Linguistic at CEFR levels B1/ B2
- c. Supporting the development of a cascade training model in Madhya Pradesh to enable Faculty to offer ongoing English language programmes
- d. Offer digital learning assistance to the students of Sri Satya Sai University of Technology and Medical Sciences to enhance their language skills
- e. To offer blended learning programs and certifications in language and pedagogy enhancement to the faculty of MPPURC regulated institution

- f. To offer insights on current language levels as well as mapping the progress of the students and establishing the impact of the Cambridge English programmes through detailed studies in the state of Madhya Pradesh
- g. To develop Sri Satya Sai University of Technology and Medical Sciences as a Cambridge Assessment English authorised centre to deliver the relevant qualifications, they need to qualify the criteria for being an authorised centre.

3. **The University may:**

- a. Mandate the following Cambridge Assessment English examinations for students and teachers as appropriate:
 - Business Preliminary for all Engineering students
 - Business Vantage for all MBA students
 - Lingua Skill for students of general science streams
 - Teaching Knowledge Test (TKT) for all Teachers
- b. Will register candidates for Cambridge Assessments & certifications for students and faculty in the 1st academic year.
- c. The university is at liberty to charge additional fees from the students and faculty for delivering Cambridge Assessments & Certifications subject to review by authorities of MPPURC

No Confidentiality:

- 1. The parties agree that neither shall disclose to any person, other than their own employees, officers, directors, agents, consultants, advisors, attorneys, accountants, auditors, those of their affiliated companies, any Confidential Information that has been disclosed to it by the other party, directly or indirectly, nor use same in any way either during the term of this MoU or at any time thereafter without the express written authority of the other party, and to promptly return all Confidential Information upon termination of this MoU and written request by the other party.
- 2. For purposes of this Agreement, "Confidential Information" shall mean information that is proprietary as to the Party disclosing same, and which is not generally known to the public or cannot be obtained other than through the Party disclosing same. This includes, but is not limited to, financial information regarding either Party, strategic business plans, marketing strategies, trade secrets consisting of programs, methods, formulae, processes, patterns, devices and compilations of information, records and specifications which have been developed or are owned by the disclosing Party. Confidential Information that subsequently becomes public information as a result of the actions of the disclosing Party shall not be considered Confidential Information for purposes of this MoU.
- 3. The parties will pay all their own costs related to the intentions and terms of this MoU, except as otherwise stated in any project agreement between the parties. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating a joint venture, partnership, a contract of




